

The STRENGTHENING STARK PLAN Strengthens You.

The Strengthening Stark Economic Plan is a shared effort to transform Stark County into a growing, younger and more prosperous community. A diverse group of partners from multiple sectors are committed to working together to implement the plan. Economic development entities, from across the county, have assumed responsibility for much of the plan's development, and the Stark Economic Development Board is responsible for overall plan coordination, in addition to measuring the progress of the plan and communicating that progress to the community.

Partners in the plan have focused on both how they will work together to develop and implement the plan, and what priorities they will address together.

STRENGTHENING NEO Strengthens You

SEDB works closely with Team NEO to attract new companies to Stark, as well as to help existing companies grow by leveraging their industry and innovation expertise. SEDB relies on Team NEO's marketing and research resources, as well as their connections to Jobs Ohio. In 2018, a tighter partnership will be formed with Team NEO, including sharing a staff member to better meet the needs of Stark County businesses. SEDB and Team NEO share a commitment to accelerating economic growth in Northeast Ohio and Stark County.



SEDB Priorities:

Strengthen Talent Supply Chain: Growing businesses need well-prepared talent. We will help companies, job seekers, educators, training programs and others to understand our county's supply of talent and our near- and longer-term demand for talent. We will help maximize alignment of supply and demand. We will celebrate businesses that attract and retain local talent, and we will encourage other companies to adopt their practices.

Retain & Grow Existing Businesses: Most jobs are created by existing companies. We will target high-growth potential companies and connect them to the resources and services they need to accelerate their growth.

Grow Targeted Industries: Key strong industries and industries projected to grow will drive economic growth in Stark County. We will develop specific strategies to accelerate the growth of these industries, including attracting new businesses. Targeted industries include: manufacturing, food processing, tourism and entertainment, and petrochemicals/plastics. We will develop and implement strategies to grow these industries.

Catalyze Entrepreneurship: Stark County has a long, rich history of entrepreneurship. We will continue the next chapter in that story by helping startups to secure the mentorship, talent and capital they need to succeed.

Improve Connective Infrastructure: Our businesses and residents need strong connections to each other and the world. These connections rely on everything from bike trails and highways to rail lines and fiber optic cables. We will identify and advocate for infrastructure investments that create stronger connections for Stark County, SEDB and Team NEO.
